

Screen Australia cinema ident DPX technical information

Image Resolution

For use of the Screen Australia logo ident there have been two resolutions supplied in DPX format: 4096X3112 and 2048x1556. These will cover 2k DCI and 4k DCI screening formats.

The logo ident has been designed to work at both 16:9 and 2.40:1 aspect ratio and will centre-cut without issue down to the correct aspect ratio. To ensure the logo ident is presented correctly, always start with the appropriate resolution. Do not scale the image.

Colour Space:

The files are supplied as 10bit DPX encoded with Alexa V3LogC. When working with the files to ensure colour accuracy it is critical you decode the files accordingly.

All grading has been done under Rec709 and quality controlled under the P3 colour gamut. The files will present correctly under P3 or Rec 709.

Preview Files:

For quick preview reference, Mp4 preview files have been supplied. These files can be used as a 'reasonably close' reference when decoding the DPX frames. Please do not use these MP4 files in production.
